

**Journey to World Sustainable Built Environment (WSBE) Conference –
Hong Kong Green Building Professional’s Delegation to Melbourne**

Programme Objective

BEAM Society Limited aims at creating a strategic platform for Hong Kong professionals in architecture, engineering, planning, and related fields to engage directly with Australian counterparts in the sustainable built environment sector. By participating in the WSBE Conference alongside targeted meetings, high-level courtesy calls, site visits to exemplary green projects, and dedicated networking sessions, the delegation aims to foster meaningful cross-border collaboration, facilitate knowledge exchange on cutting-edge sustainability practices and policies, and enhance Hong Kong’s competitiveness and influence in the global green building market. This initiative is designed to deliver far more than conference attendance — it offers a rare opportunity to build lasting professional partnerships that will drive innovation and excellence in sustainable development for both Hong Kong and Australia.

Programme Details

Visit Date: 8 – 12 June 2026 (Monday – Friday)

Location: Melbourne, Australia

Language: English

Target Participants: Professionals and practitioners from green building sector OR building and construction-related services (Hong Kong professionals from key sectors including architecture, landscape architecture, engineering, planning, and surveying)

Group Size: 20-25

Participation Fee: **HK\$4,000**

- Participant would be required to pay a standard participation fees that include 1) the comprehensive tour arrangement for the 5-day trip, 2) meals during the delegation programme, and 3) in-town transportation.
- Participants are responsible for arranging 1) their own transportation between Hong Kong and Melbourne, 2) their own hotel accommodation, 3) the registration fee of WSBE conference and 4) Australian ETA visa service fee.
